‘Zoonicorn’ Movie in the Works with Dream Mechanics for 2027

The family comedy-adventure is set for limited theatrical and full streaming release in **Q4 of 2027**.

Producers include **Deb Pierson** (*Baby Einstein*, *Slayers*) and Dream Mechanics Founder **Devon Kliger** (*Daredevil: Born Again*, *Rainbow High*, *The Furby Movie*), with Lubratt and brand & licensing director Smith serving as executive producers on behalf of Zoonicorn LLC.
